Approval - Dangerous Goods Training Course

1 Application

This instrument applies to Janet Lucille McCracken [ARN 575343] and Peter John McCracken [ARN 575344], trading as Airsafe Transport Training [ARN 511850] (the *Course Approval Holder*), the training course materials submitted to CASA (the *training courses*) and persons who undertake the training course (the *employees*).

2 Approval

The training courses are approved as being appropriate for;

- a) Group A employees
- b) Group B employees;
- c) Group C employees;
- d) Group D employees;
- e) Group F employees; and
- f) Employees with a combination of responsibilities for groups A, B, C or D, as per the matrices contained in Tables 1 and 2 of Schedule 1.

3 Conditions

- a) Changes to the Civil Aviation Act 1988, the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations 1998, the International Civil Aviation Organization Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air, and the International Air Transport Association Dangerous Goods Regulations, in force from time to time, must be reflected, as applicable, in the course material.
- b) This approval is subject to the maintenance of a satisfactory standard of training.
- c) Where any course is limited to certain DG Class/Hazard Divisions, then those workbooks, promotional material and certificates of training are to reflect those limitations.
- d) Any *employees* undertaking a recertification course are to provide evidence that their existing training is current (i.e. is current according to the period set out in CASR 92.090) and was not limited by dangerous goods class or division less than the course which will be undertaken.
- e) The course Approval holder is required to keep records of courses, students and instructors for a minimum period of 36 months from the completion of the course.
- f) The course approval holder is to make training records available to CASA.
- g) In the event that the Course Approval Holder ceases to trade then an electronic record of the last 36 months of training records is to be submitted to CASA.
- h) CASA may revoke this approval if it is necessary in the interests of the safety of air navigation.

4 Date of Expiry

This instrument expires at the end of November 2025.
