It also provides an understanding of procedures that will help detect hidden hazards when accepting air freight.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>About the course</b></p> <p>This course helps Cabin Crew interpret and apply the Australian Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) and the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) for commercial aircraft. This course covers Dangerous Goods (DG) recognition, passenger and crew allowances, plus suggested response.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>About the course</b></p> <p>This course helps Ground Handling Crew (Ramp personnel, check-in staff, HLO and security) interpret and apply the Australian Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) and the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) for commercial aircraft. This course covers Dangerous Goods (DG) recognition, passenger and crew allowances, segregation of dangerous goods, hidden hazards, plus suggested response.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Who Should Do this Course?</b></p> <p>The course is suitable for anyone who requires a general understanding of shipping dangerous goods by air. The course is required under CASA legislation for airline and air-freight forwarder staff involved with acceptance and/or handling of air freight including</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Flight Crew &amp; Cabin Crew Ramp/Loading Personnel Load Planners Check-in Staff Drivers &amp; Warehouse Personnel</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Who Should Do this Course?</b></p> <p>The course is suitable for <b>Cabin Crew</b> who require a general understanding of shipping dangerous goods by air. The course is required under CASA legislation for airline Cabin Crew (<i>Employee Category D personnel</i>).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Who Should Do this Course?</b></p> <p>The course is suitable for Passenger <b>Handling Staff</b> <b>General Air Cargo Acceptance Personnel</b> <b>Aircraft Loading Personnel</b> <b>Helicopter Landing Operators (HLO)</b> <b>Security Staff</b> who require a general understanding of the carriage of dangerous goods by air. The course is required under CASA legislation for airline staff as mentioned above (<i>Employee Category B &amp; E personnel</i>).</p>
<p>This course <b>WILL NOT</b> qualify you to accept dangerous goods.</p>	<p>It is <b>NOT SUITABLE</b> for Flight Crew, Load Planners, Non-DG Acceptance freight staff Ramp personnel, Check-in agents, Shippers or DG Acceptance personnel.</p>	<p>It is <b>NOT SUITABLE</b> for Flight Crew, Cabin Crew, Load Planners, Dangerous Goods Shippers or Dangerous Goods Acceptance personnel</p>
