# One day course, Computer-Based or Virtual Training

# Purpose

This course assists organizations transporting dangerous goods by road, and road freight industry personnel, interpret and apply the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail (ADG7.7). An understanding of the concepts behind the Code will ensure compliance with the law and protect those who transport dangerous goods.

# What you get

The course is designed to provide comprehensive training in the theory and practical aspects of shipping dangerous goods by road. Throughout the course, you will examine the ADG code and learn a systematic approach to packaging and documenting a hazardous shipment for road transport. There are plenty of follow-up exercises to reinforce the knowledge acquired and to ensure all Australian regulations are complied with.

All training materials are supplied. Participants are advised to download ADG7.7 from our website free-of-charge.

# Course Qualification and Recognition

A certificate is issued on successful completion of an end-of-course questionnaire. There is no qualification period stipulated in ADG7.7 however, as the Regulations change and memory fades, it is recommended participants revalidate every **TWO YEARS**.

Licensing is required for Drivers moving **BULK DANGEROUS GOODS**. This course is **NOT** suitable for those drivers

### Who Should Attend?

If you are involved with the packaging, documentation, consigning or control of hazardous materials for transport by road, then this course is for you. It's also ideal for freight forwarders and consolidators involved with road freight, store and dispatch personnel and anyone involved with transporting dangerous goods by road.

This course is **not suitable** for drivers transporting dangerous goods in bulk.

# Level of Competency

No previous knowledge or experience with road transport or dangerous goods is required to complete the course. A basic level of English comprehension and literacy skills is required.

# DANGEROUS GOODS TRANSPORTING BASICS

# Classify

Are the substances or articles hazardous, what is their degree of hazard?

## Identify

Choose the most appropriate proper shipping name by the items use, properties, chemical name or hazard description.

# Package

Ensure the dangerous goods are packaged in approved packaging to the specified instructions.

## Mark and Label

Marking and labeling the packages/containers with the correct hazard label and dangerous goods information ensures that all handling the consignment are aware of the hazard.

#### **Document**

Record the dangerous goods information on appropriate forms for reporting and investigation if required.

## **Transport**

Ensure bulk and placard loads are carried on suitably placarded vehicles and drivers are aware of their responsibilities.
