Class 4. Flammable solids are also considered to be dangerous goods. Since flammable solids have a flammable nature, the name itself speaks volumes, can be divided into three divisions.

- 4.1. Flammable solids, self-reactive and related substances and desensitized explosives.
- 4.2. Substances liable to spontaneous combustion
- 4.3. Substances that in contact with water emit flammable gases



This mark must be a square set at 45 Degree angle, that is diamond shape. The line forming this diamond shape must be 2 mm and the size must be 100 x 100 mm
