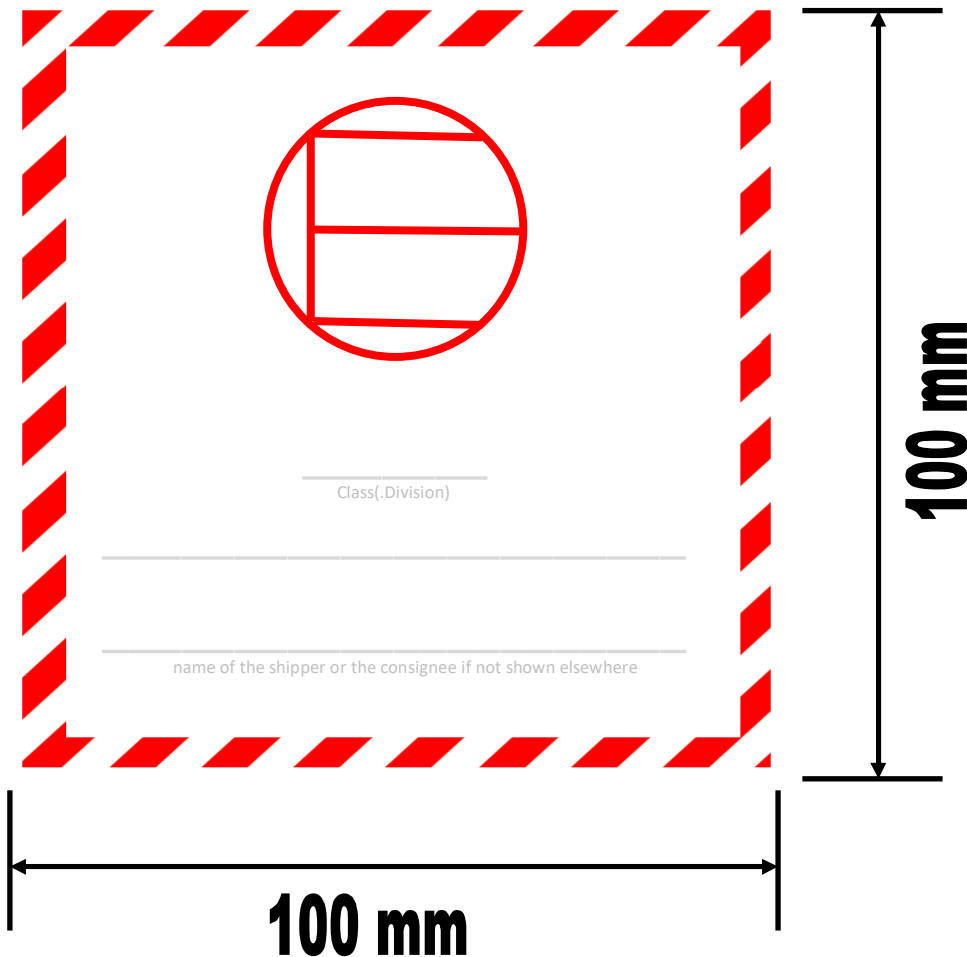


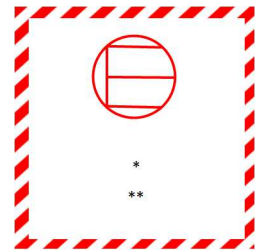
Handling Label: Excepted Quantities



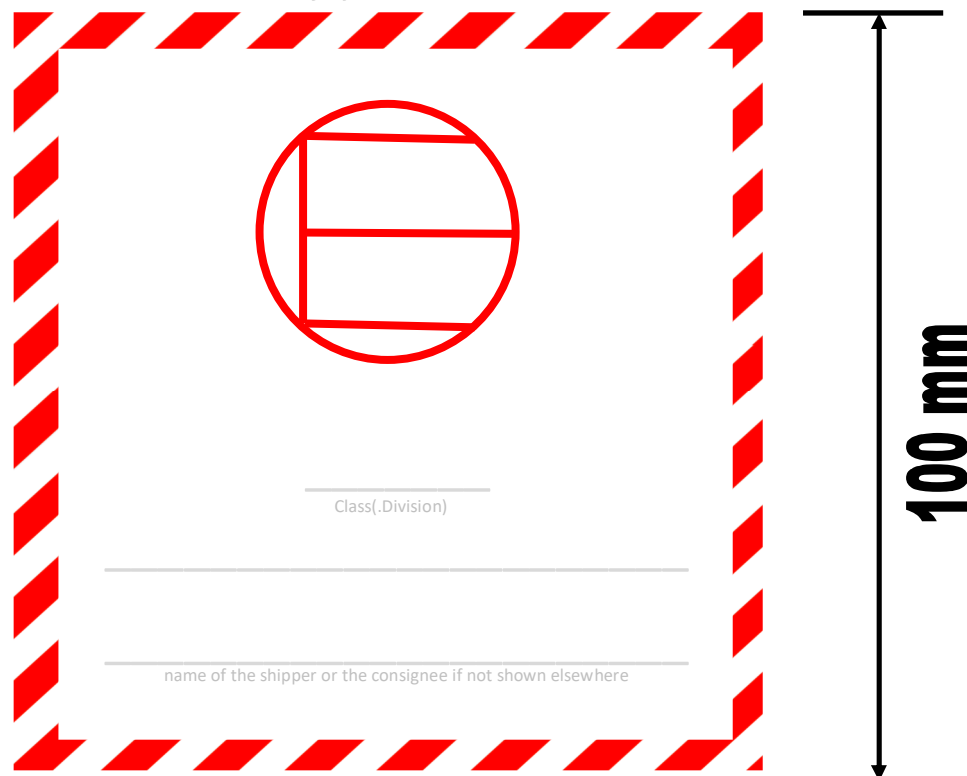
Packages containing excepted quantities of dangerous goods prepared according to the regulation must show the primary hazard class (and division, if applicable) of each of the dangerous goods contained in the package must be shown in the mark. Where the name of the consignor or consignee is not shown elsewhere on the package this information must be included within the mark.

- (*) The class/division number must be shown in this location.

- (**) The name of the shipper or the consignee must be shown in this location if not shown elsewhere on the package.



This mark must be a square and the minimum size must be 100 x 100 mm
